Factor that affect the text legibility

- Sizes –determine the legibility and readability of the text.
- The color of background and foreground
- Style of the text
- Text leading (Space above & below a font or line space)

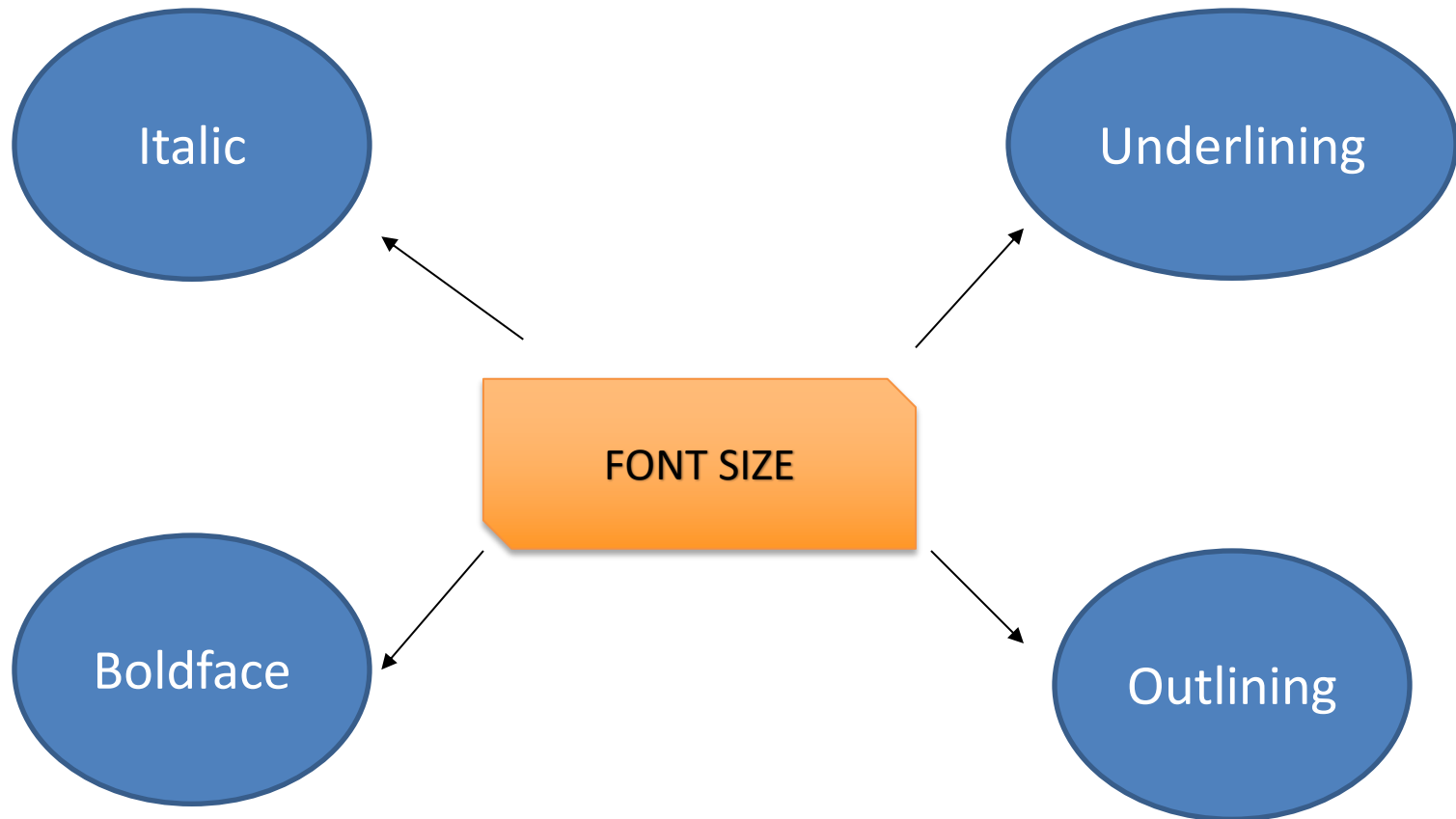

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Serifs are the best suited for body text 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use sans serif face for small (smaller than 8 pt) and for huge size

Post Script

- PostScript is a technique to describe an images in mathematical construct terms.
- PostScript character is scalable and can be draw more fast.
- PostScript have 2 kind of type which are

TrueType

- TrueType is a scalable outline font system & allow to draw character in low resolution.
- Apple & Microsoft develop the TrueType methodology.

COMPUTER & TEXT

OpenType

- Adobe & Microsoft develop international standard of OpenType.
- It incorporate the PostScript & TrueType top features.

COMPUTER & TEXT

The set of characters

- The American Standard Code for Information Interchange (ASCII) is a **7bit coding system**.
- The character set that is extended is usually fill with ANSI standard character.
- The ISO-Latin-1 character set is use in programming the HTML text page.
- Unicode is a 16bit architectures for multilingual text and character encode.
- The shared symbol of every character set are unified in to collection of symbols (script).

Multimedia

- The combination of texts, graphic, and audios element into a one presentation is called multimedia.
- If the user can control the presentation process/flow, the it is interactive multimedia.
- A hypermedia is made when a structured of link element is provide to the enduser to navigate and interact to the interactive multimedia.

- Hypertext means organize word crosslinking, image, & any Web element.
- Hypertext system is a system in that word are keyed or index to other word.
- A hypertext system enable the users to navigate thru texts in a nonlinear method.
